The goal

Jazira's wider ambition is to connect coastal ecosystem restoration with community livelihoods and responsible blue economy development. Phase 0 would build the conservation knowledge, practical skills, community plans and evidence needed to inform a future restoration phase.

What the first grant would support

A proposed ten-day conservation capacity programme in the Jazira coastal area and adjacent communities, approximately 23 km south of Mogadishu, followed by structured 30-, 60- and 90-day follow-up. The final cohort, schedule and field sites require confirmation.

Learn and practise. Conservation, native vegetation and nursery skills, soil and land management, conservation-compatible livelihoods, governance and environmental monitoring.

Teach and organise. A proposed 60 participants, 15 community trainers and six community action plans. At least 40% women participation is targeted, with priority for youth and displaced households.

Follow up and evaluate. Knowledge and practical-competency assessments, community action-plan follow-up, independent programme evaluation and an external financial audit.

Who does what

AECBED is the local delivery counterpart for training, community coordination, Somali-language facilitation, field logistics and follow-up within an authorised, funded phase. **Terra Vita Global B.V.** provides operating controls, evidence architecture, monitoring, financial controls and Hub integration. Competent authorities, communities and donors retain their respective permissions, consent and funding decisions.

Programme targets are proposed, not achieved results. Ecological recovery, livelihood gains and any wider restoration scale remain to be demonstrated.

The latest reviewed status record (30 August 2026) records **USD 0 committed** and a **USD 147,900 gap**. Current commitments must be reconfirmed during diligence. A separate **EUR 1.05 million wider planning envelope** has a different scope and currency; it is not an award and is not added to this ask. Programme grants are separate from Terra Vita company financing.

Conditions before delivery

Funding, current implementing-partner standing, competent-authority and site permissions, safeguards, baseline approval, supplier quotations and independent financial sign-off must be in place before mobilisation. Delivered operating controls and accepted pre-mobilisation records do not establish live implementation or a financed government mandate.

The proposed internal release profile is 20% / 45% / 25% / 10%, linked to mobilisation authority, delivery readiness, verified outputs and close-out. Donor acceptance and release authority remain separately required. Grant terms must preserve the non-debt position; no carbon credits or financial return are offered.
